

Catechesis involves the formation in faith of people in the parish.

Since Immaculate Conception is such a small parish with people coming from diverse areas, regular evening instructions are not offered, other than the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults who are coming into the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil.
